V. COMPETITIONS

There will be an Individual ranking per Country, per Region and for the World for all 3 Categories. In order to be in the Individual ranking per country, per region and the world for 3 Categories, an athlete/horse combination must complete in a Minimum of Two Competitions. Only the results of the best Two Competitions per Category will be counted for the rankings.

Horses which entered in any of the FEI Jumping World Challenge competitions -3^{rd} competition (No. 1 – 3) are <u>not</u> allowed to start in HKEF Local Jumping Competitions No. 4 - 7 on 17 December 2022 (Sat) but may start in the HKEF Local Jumping Competitions No. 8 - 11 on 18 November 2022 (Sun) which will be held in the afternoon after the completion of the FEI Jumping World Challenge 3^{rd} competition.

In case an athlete is riding more than one horse, the declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds.

- Horses cannot be ridden by more than one rider in one Category throughout the FEI Jumping World Challenge during the same year.
- Athletes may ride more than one horse in a category but the results of only one horse will count. This horse must be declared before the first round of the competition in which the athlete takes part. The declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds of all competitions. The athlete must complete the official <u>FEI Declaration Form</u>, sign it and submit it to the HKEF before the first round of the first competition in which the athlete takes part.

**Any member who wishes to compete in local ranking competitions of affiliated shows from 1st September to 31st August will be required to pay a Rider Registration Fee of HK\$ 400 and a Horse Registration Fee of HK\$400 for his or her competition horse before the start of the local ranking competition in which he or she has submitted entries to the OC. Affiliated shows refer to shows organized by the HKEF or other riding schools in accordance with HKEF Rules, or in the case of international competitions, under the Rules of the FEI.

***Any member who wishes to compete in FEI competitions from 1st January to 31st December will be required to pay a Rider Registration Fee of HK\$ 2,000 and a Horse Registration Fee of HK\$ 400 for his or her competition horse before the start of the FEI competition(s) in which he or she has submitted entries to HKEF. FEI competitions refer to shows organized by the HKEF or other organizers in accordance with the Rules of the FEI.

**** FEI Horse Registration is required for any horse competing in FEI competitions.

Athletes and Horses participating in the FEI Jumping World Challenge do NOT need to be registered with the FEI (FEI Jumping World Challenge Rules 2022) but need to be registered for local affiliated shows.

All athletes will participate in the Event under their own risk. Their participation confirms their acknowledgement that in case of an accident during the event or a training session they disclaim the enactment of any civil rights which may arise against other athletes participating in the event or the training session.

Photos & videos taken during the competition will be used for HKEF Media / Promotion purpose upon athletes' consent.

The HKEF is not responsible for the following liabilities:

- Any decision of an Athlete to remount, and continue riding whether made by the Athlete himself / herself, or his / her parent, guardian, instructor or coach, and regardless of whether a doctor's opinion is sought after a fall.
- Any injuries, diseases, and accidents to the horses, athletes and officials in the time of transportation and during the competition period.
- Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating riders and horses in the time of transportation and during the competition period.

2. EVENT'S ORGANISATION (HKEF Rules Art. 101)

The Show Director reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the Show Director or the Secretary General of the HKEF. Modifications during the event may only be made by the Ground Jury.
