VI. ADDITIONAL AWARDS

Champion Awards

The leading horse and rider combination from each level will be awarded Champion. This will be presented at the Prize Giving Ceremony following the completion of the competition. Competitors must compete in both tests at that level to be eligible for champion points. In the event of a tie, the Champion will be the combination with the highest aggregate percentage at that level.

Preliminary Champion

- Preliminary Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 1 and 2

Novice Champion

- Novice Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 3 and 4

Elementary Champion

- Elementary Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 5 and 6

Medium Champion

- Medium Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 7 and 8

Advanced Medium Champion

- Advanced Medium Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 9 and 10

Advanced Champion

- Advanced Champion will be awarded to the leading horse and rider combination that achieves the highest combined percentage score from Classes 11 and 12

Best Presented Award for Horse and Rider

An award for the Best Presented Horse and Rider combination to be judged by the President of the Ground Jury and will be awarded at the Prize-Giving Ceremony following the completion of the whole competition This will be judged on overall presentation, turnout and professionalism

VII. DRESSAGE HORSE OF THE YEAR TEAM CHALLENGE

The Dressage Horse of the Year Show Team Challenge ('the Team Challenge'') is a team event made up of one (1) junior and one (1) senior rider as per the following:

- 1. Each team must consist of one (1) senior team member (born in 2008 or earlier) and one (1) junior team member (born in 2009 or later)
- 2. Each rider can compete in one team only. The team must name the team leader at the time of entries
- 3. If a rider/horse is unable to participate in an event due to veterinary/medical reasons, a substitution can be made. A written declaration must be provided from a veterinarian/medical doctor. The replacement rider/horse can be named up to one (1) hour prior to the published start time of the first class. The written declaration must be provided to EFHKC as soon as possible
- 4. There are 12 classes at this year's Dressage Horse of the Year Show. Each member of the team can submit a maximum of two (2) entries per class
- 5. Point(s) allocation:
