V. COMPETITIONS

There will be rankings for individuals based on their performance in three categories, categorized by country, region, and the world. To qualify for the individual rankings, rider/horse combination must participate in a minimum of two competitions. The rankings will consider only the results from the two best competitions in each category.

Horses that have participated in the FEI Jumping World Challenge - 1st Competition - No. 1 - 3 are prohibited from competing in the EFHKC Local Jumping Competition - No. 4 - 7 on October 21, 2023 (Saturday). However, they are allowed to participate in the EFHKC Local Jumping Competition - No. 8 - 11 on October 22, 2023 (Sunday) if they do not intend to enter any of the FEI Jumping World Challenge - 2nd Competition - No. 1 - 3 on the same day.

- Horses cannot be ridden by more than one rider in one Category throughout the FEI Jumping World Challenge during the same year.
- Athletes may ride more than one horse in a category but the results of only one horse will count. This horse must be declared before the first round of the competition in which the athlete takes part. The declared horse must be ridden first in all rounds of all competitions. The athlete must complete the official [FEI Declaration Form](#), sign it and submit it to the EFHKC before the first round of the first competition in which the athlete takes part.

**Any member who wishes to compete in local ranking competitions of affiliated shows from 1st September to 31st August will be required to pay a Rider Registration Fee of HK\$ 400 and a Horse Registration Fee of HK\$400 for his or her competition horse before the start of the local ranking competition in which he or she has submitted entries to the OC. Affiliated shows refer to shows organized by the EFHKC or other riding schools in accordance with EFHKC Rules, or in the case of international competitions, under the Rules of the FEI.

X. OTHER REGULATIONS

1. Liabilities

All athletes will participate in the Event under their own risk. Their participation confirms their acknowledgement that in case of an accident during the event or a training session they disclaim the enactment of any civil rights which may arise against other athletes participating in the event or the training session.

Photos & videos taken during the competition will be used for EFHKC Media / Promotion purpose upon athletes' consent.

The EFHKC is not responsible for the following liabilities:

- Any decision of an Athlete to remount, and continue riding whether made by the Athlete himself / herself, or his / her parent, guardian, instructor or coach, and regardless of whether a doctor's opinion is sought after a fall.
- Any injuries, diseases, and accidents to the horses, athletes and officials in the time of transportation and during the competition period.
- Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating riders and horses in the time of transportation and during the competition period.

2. EVENT'S ORGANISATION (EFHKC Rules Art. 101)

The Show Director reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the Show Director or the Secretary General of the EFHKC. Modifications during the event may only be made by the Ground Jury.
