 <u>Form</u>, sign it and submit it to the EFHKC before the first round of the first competition in which the athlete
 takes part.

Affiliated shows refer to shows organized by the EFHKC or other riding schools in accordance with EFHKC Rules, or in the case of international competitions, under the Rules of the FEI.

X. OTHER REGULATIONS

1. Liabilities

All athletes will participate in the Event under their own risk. Their participation confirms their acknowledgement that in case of an accident during the event or a training session they disclaim the enactment of any civil rights which may arise against other athletes participating in the event or the training session.

Photos & videos taken during the competition will be used for EFHKC Media / Promotion purpose upon athletes' consent.

The EFHKC is not responsible for the following liabilities:

- Any decision of an Athlete to remount, and continue riding whether made by the Athlete himself / herself, or his / her parent, guardian, instructor or coach, and regardless of whether a doctor's opinion is sought after a fall.
- Any injuries, diseases, and accidents to the horses, athletes and officials in the time of transportation and during the competition period.
- Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating riders and horses in the time of transportation and during the competition period.
