- Perpetual Trophies (Wrinklies Rice Bowl and the Grimshaw Plate) will be awarded at the End-of-Season Celebration Dinner at the New Clubhouse, Beas River Country Club on 9 June 2024 (Sunday).

## VI. Jumping Horse of the Year Show Team Challenge

The Jumping Horse of the Year Show Team Challenge (“the Team Challenge”) is introduced for the first time in this year’s Jumping Horse of the Year Show. The aim is to foster relationships between junior and senior riders in Hong Kong and encourage strategic planning in winning the Team Challenge.

1. Team component: Each team is made up of two members. The senior member must be born in 2008 or earlier and the other member born after 2008.
2. Each rider can only enter as a member of one team only. The team must name the team leader at the time of submitting the entry to the Team Challenge and this would be the contact person and the person who makes the final decision whenever dispute arises. Once the team members submit their entries, there cannot be any substitute or changes except for the situation outlined below.
3. If a rider/horse is unable to participate in an event due to veterinary/medical reasons, the team can find a replacement to fill the place. A written declaration from a veterinarian/medical doctor is required to justify the substitution. The replacement rider/horse can be named up to 1 hour prior to the start of Class 1. The written declaration must be provided to EFHKC as soon as possible.
4. There are 6 classes of different obstacle height in this year’s Jumping Horse of the Year Show. The members of the team can enter into different classes of their choice to earn as many points as they can. The following table sets out the points you can earn from the different classes. All points earned by the members of each team at the completion of the competition will be accumulated to arrive at the results of the Team Challenge.

6. In the event of a tie for a placement, both riders will receive the corresponding points as per the table as listed.
7. The top three teams with the highest accumulated points in the Team Challenge will receive prize money and a trophy. If there are more than 3 teams with the highest accumulated points, all the teams with the same highest points will share the prize money for the equal place.
8. The Team Challenge awards will be presented approximately 30 minutes after the completion of all competitions. All Team Challenge winners must participate in the prize-giving ceremony wearing riding gear with a show jacket.

\*\*Any member who wishes to compete in local ranking competitions of affiliated shows from 1st September to 31st August will be required to pay an annual subscription of HK\$400 for the Rider Registration and Horse Registration for his or her competition horse before the start of the local ranking competition in which he or she has submitted entries to the Organising Committee. Affiliated shows refer to shows organized by the EFHKC or other riding schools in accordance with EFHKC Rules, or in the case of international competitions, under the Rules of the FEI.

## XI. OTHER REGULATIONS

### 1. Liabilities

All athletes will participate in the Event under their own risk. Their participation confirms their acknowledgement that in case of an accident during the event or a training session they disclaim the enactment of any civil rights which may arise against other athletes participating in the event or the training session.

Photos & videos taken during the competition will be used for EFHKC Media / Promotion including but not limited to Facebook and EFHKC Website purpose upon athletes' consent.

**The EFHKC is not responsible** for the following liabilities:


- Any decision of an Athlete to remount, and continue riding whether made by the Athlete himself / herself, or his / her parent, guardian, instructor or coach, and regardless of whether a doctor's opinion is sought after a fall.
- Any injuries, diseases, and accidents to the horses, athletes and officials in the time of transportation and during the competition period.

- Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating riders and horses in the time of transportation and during the competition period.

## 2. EVENT'S ORGANISATION (EFHKC Rules Art. 101)

The Show Director reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the Show Director or the Secretary General of the EFHKC. Modifications during the event may only be made by the Ground Jury.
