- Any loss or damages to any third party caused by the participating riders and horses in the time of transportation and during the competition period.

The OC reserves the right to modify the schedule in order to clarify any matters or matters arising from an omission or due to unforeseen circumstances. All modifications made to the schedule prior to the event must have the approval of the President of HKEF (or his authorized representative).
